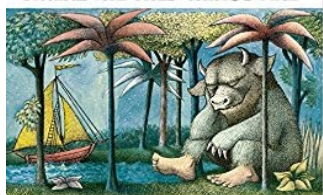


Year 1 'Who started the Fire of London?' Spring 1

English

This is the book we will be looking at during our English lessons. We will be focusing on writing sentences with capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will also be using the joining word 'and' to extend sentences as well as adjectives to describe the characters and setting.

History

As Historians, we will be learning all about The Great Fire Of London. We will be researching and finding out facts about the fire. We will also be comparing what London used to be like and what it is like now.



Science

As scientist, we will be exploring everyday materials. We will be identifying and testing different materials such as plastic, glass, wood, fabric, metal and paper. We will also be learning about the famous architect Iseambard Kingdom Brunel.

Art

As Artists, we will be focusing on 'Mood'. We will then be learning how to make different prints in order to complete a collage of The Great Fire of London.

Music

We will be working in groups to practice and perform songs in front of our classes. Our song this term is called 'In the Groove'.

Computing

During computing this half term, we will be doing information literacy. We will be scanning QR codes on the iPad, practicing keyboard skills and using Kiddle to re-search topics.

Maths

In Maths, we are focusing on Addition and Subtraction within 20 and Place Value within 50. Children in Year 1 will be building their skills and learning through the concrete, pictorial and abstract concept.
