Year 6 Trip Industrial Museum

Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s),

As part of our work linked to our history topic, The Industrial Revolution, we will be taking Year Six to visit the Bradford Industrial Museum in Fagley.

Children will have the opportunity to engage in role-play, experiencing lessons in a Victorian classroom. They will also visit the other exhibitions in the museum, learning about how people lived and worked in the 19th century.

Your child will need to wear sensible, flat shoes and a waterproof coat as we shall be walking to and from the museum. In keeping with the theme of the trip, children can (if they wish!) dress in practical, "Victorian" clothing. Suggestions include:

White pinafore or smock	Dark boots / shoes
Dark skirt/dress (as long as possible)	Flat caps/bonnets
Woollen shawls	Long grey/ dark school trousers
White shirt with stiff collar	Waist-coats
Dark knee high socks (pulled over trousers) or tights	

We will be leaving school at 9.15am and will return to school at approximately 3.00, just before home time. Classes will go on different days: **Banyan and Holly on Tuesday 31st October, Sycamore on Wednesday 1st November.** Please provide a **packed lunch** for your child on their designated day; school can provide this if your child is eligible for free school meals.

The cost of the trip will be **£3.80** per child. Please sign the slip below, giving permission for your child to attend, and pay via Parent Pay by **Monday 2nd October 2023.**
