
<u>Year 5 Autumn 1 2023</u>

English

In our English lessons, we have made a great start to the new term by beginning our new core text; Podkin One Ear by Kieran Larwood. Maths

In Maths, this term we will start off by revisiting place value . Place value is the value of each digit in a number; it is important to understand that while a digit can be the same, its value depends on where it is in a number. We will then use this knowledge to secure written methods for both addition and subtraction before applying these methods to problem solving. It is so important that your child learns their multiplication facts as it will really help to make their learning much easier—we will also use these facts when dividing and focusing



The pupils will learn a selection of the key phonemes to facilitate accurate and authentic pronunciation as part of their language learning experience. Each of the lessons is accompanied by a song that pupils will be encouraged to actively partici-
