

School council meeting minutes 10/3/17

Matters Arising.

1. Changes of staff on school council - It was announced that Miss Yaxley is no longer involved in the running of the school council. The school council would like to thank her for all of her hard work. Mr Christy will continue to be involved of the running of the school council and will be joined by Mrs Brooks and Miss Sultana.
2. School Dinners - Pupils discussed the school dinners and listed several improvements that they think could be made to the content of school dinners and other improvements. It was decided to set up a committee to look at school dinners.
3. PE last half term of this year - It was discussed that pupils are able to decide as a year group what activities they would like to do for the last half term of this year (Summer 2). School councillors should supply ideas to Mr Christy by the end of Friday 17th March. The ideas will be looked at and voted on in year groups.

The possibility of having a competition to design a new certificate was mentioned. Sara and Husney (Year 4) are going to lead on this.
5. Bikes - It has been mentioned by a few pupils that they would like to come to school on their

bikes. Mr Christy discussed the issues that he can see that would need to be sorted out before this could happen (safety and cost). Amal and Tayyab (Year 6) to meet Mr Mason-Edwards to see if this is possible.

6. Buddy Stop - Mrs Fairchild would like the councillors to pick the signs for the new buddy stops.

7. House points roll over - Mr Christy discussed the idea that when a house wins the house points they can hold on to that win and save it to get a larger prize after several wins. Ideas for what those prizes can be are wanted. Any ideas please see your school councillors.

8. Mr Christy to speak to Kelly (Year 6) about any progress made with chopping down the bushes at the bottom of the hill on the playground.
