






Year 4 Summer

We will be learning on Shapes, Statistics and also Position and Direction.</p> <p>The shapes below are all types of quadrilaterals.</p> 	<p>English</p> <p>For our non-fiction unit. We will be looking at explanation texts. We will connect to our science learning by writing about the human body. In our fiction unit, we will be writing a story based on The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane.</p>
