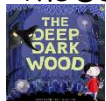


Year 1 Summer 1 2025

We hope you had a restful half term break and are ready to start the new half term.

English

For Drawing Club, we will be reading a book called "The Deep Dark Wood".



Everyone knows it's no place to go for a stroll. There are monsters and trolls and giants everywhere, not to mention the Big Bad Wolf! Wait a minute! What's that sweet little girl doing in the deep dark wood? We will be building on our writing skills by using capital letters, finger spaces, question marks and the conjunction "and". We will also be working on poetry and simple recount of events.

Science

Our learning will be based around the book 'The Lion Inside'. We will be continuing with our seasonal walk to expand our knowledge. We will also be observing, describing and comparing with lots of investigations taking place.

Math's

In Math's, we are focusing on multiplication and division. We will also be learning fractions and consolidating previous learning. Children in Year 1 will be building their skills and learning through the concrete, pictorial and abstract concept.

We will also be consolidating previous learning. Children will also be focusing on counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.

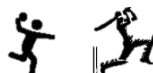


DT

In DT we are looking at mechanisms to make a moving story book. We will be identifying different mechanisms such as side to side and up and down sliders before designing and construction our books.

PE

Indoors, we will be learning how to play dodgeball. Children will show control of a ball with basic actions. Outdoors, we will be learning how to play cricket. Children will learn skills for striking and fielding.



PSHCE

Our story this term is Angry Arthur by Hiawyn Oram. Arthur wants to stay up late and watch TV, and when his mum says no, Arthur gets very angry. His anger becomes a storm cloud, a hurricane, an earthquake that has shockwaves in space. What will help Arthur calm down? We will be completing 6 lessons each one will cover a topic related to the story.

RE

In RE our focus What did Jesus teach and how did he live?

History

We will have the opportunity to explore some local history in our local area. We will be learning about the following:

- How and why do we use the park now?
- What are the key features of the park?
- How has the park changed over time?
- Who was Robert Peel and why was he significant?



Computing & Online Safety

In computing our focus is creating media. Children will have ago at doing digital writing. We will be learning about online bullying/ reputation and relationships.
