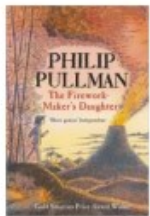


Year 4 Spring 2 2024

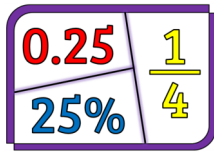
English

The children will focus heavily on the text, 'The Firework-Maker's Daughter' by Philip Pullman in order to understand the key features of a journey story. In addition, they will develop their comprehension skills through analysis of the text and conventions of story-telling. Later on in the term, we will be writing diary entries from the perspective of the characters from the book.



Maths

In Maths, we will start the half-term focusing on fractions. These will be reintroduced to the children and explored in further detail. Additionally, we will learn about what decimals are and how we can use our fraction knowledge to help us interpret them. We will learn how to convert fractions into decimals and how to find equivalents. As well, the children will continue to practice their times table knowledge.



Computing

In our Computing lessons, we will look at how data is collected over time and how this information is all around us. Children will use the iPads to collect their own data, recording and evaluating their findings.

Geography

In our Geography lessons we are exploring The countries of the UK, what are our home nations and the major cities within them. We will be exploring famous landmarks from around the UK and comparing Human and Physical features. If you are travelling to any other cities or places within the UK discuss the journey time, which direction you are travelling in and what landmarks you might see or pass on the way.

Science

We are continuing with looking at Habitats and Food chains for the first half of this half term. We will then be moving onto Animals and the Digestion System. This will involve a trip to the Farm after Easter where we will explore the diet and digestion of animals in comparison to ourselves. Think about what other animals eat and their diets.

RE

In RE, we will be focusing on Islam. We will be learning about the five Pillars of Islam and how Muslims apply these pillars into their daily lives.



Guided Reading

Throughout Guided Reading, we will be looking at both fiction and non-fiction texts. Where possible, these will have cross-curricular links to our other topics to provide further information and understanding for the children. Furthermore, there will be other opportunities to look at various books linked to our English text type, journey.

Art

Pattern is our focus in art. We will be looking closely at Fabergé eggs, different patterns around us, especially patterns seen in nature, and designing our very own egg made out of clay and mosaic tiles.
