As it gets colder, please send your child to school with a warm, waterproof coat, everyday.

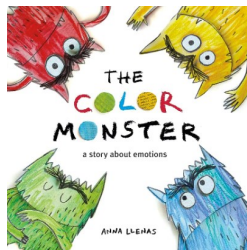
Independence

We encourage children to be independent at Nursery. It is important that children learn to go to the toilet independently. Nursery staff will be on hand to support children with toilet training, but it is important that children also use the toilet at home.
