Welcome!

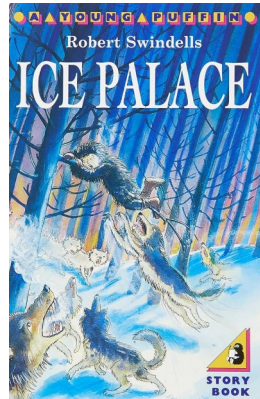
We hope you had a fantastic October break and are ready for the exciting learning that will be happening.

Maths

Building on our understanding of Hundreds, Tens and Ones, and understanding the value of the digits, the children will move onto the formal methods of addition and subtraction by laying calculations out in columns. We will begin this by using equipment to represent the hundreds, tens and ones.

English

Science

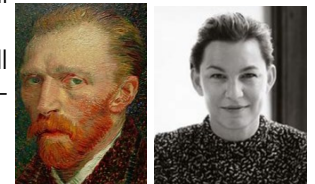
This half term, pupils will be studying different types of rocks. They will investigate the different properties that rocks have and how different rocks are formed. We will also be finding out about fossils and how they are formed. This links to the work we are doing in History and Art.

History

We will be learning about what life was like in the Stone Age. We have an amazing immersive workshop booked in as well as a virtual visitor to enhance the in class learning. We will be looking at artefacts and asking how these can help us find out about life in the distant past.

Art

We will be learning about the famous artists, Vincent Van Gogh and Elizabeth Peyton. We will explore the use of various pencils when sketching. We will begin to draw with close observation and carry out initial sketches in preparation for portraits. After looking at the artists' works, we will create portraits of some of the staff members in our school.
