Science

We will be continuing our topic about Materials. We will learning all about different materials and their properties. We will be investigating which materials are more suitable than others for a specific purpose.



Geography

In Geography we are focusing on 'My City and Yours'. Over this half term, we will be

looking at the city we live in and comparing it to a non–European city. The children will be looking at the human and physical features of the UK and comparing them to another non-European city. We will explore what it is like to live in a non-European city and compare it to the UK.



In RE we will be answering the question 'How can we make good choices?'

The unit starts off by looking at what makes a happy classroom, and why rules are important. The children will then explore the moral codes from Christianity, Judaism and Islam including the Ten Commandments and the Five Pillars.
