Maths

Drawing Club

These groups are following the Read, Write Inc programme which is designed to meet their specific reading and writing needs.



Science

Our unit this term is all about Animals including Humans. We will be identifying, naming and drawing the basic parts of the human/animal body and say which part is associated with which sense. We will also be observing seasonal changes and describing weather.

History


