In Maths we will be moving on to numbers 6 to 10, but also continuing to reinforce numbers 1 to 5. We will look at shape towards the end of the half term by introducing simple shapes to the children such as square, triangle and circle.

Some children will be introduced to phonics this half term, using Read, Write Inc like the rest of school.

For a majority of the children we will be focussing on rhyming words and identifying which words rhyme in books. Help your child with this by making up silly rhymes.

How you can help your child
