We hope you are well rested and are ready for the exciting learning that will be happening this term.


Maths

Children will learn how tell time to the nearest minute. They will also look at the 24 hour clock. Children will learn the properties of shapes and explore mass and capacity.

They will continue to revise and consolidate learning on the four operations and the times tables.

English

This half term we are taking inspiration from our class novel Toto: The Wizard of Oz As Told by the Dog to write stories with portals. We are continuing to practice using speech marks and proof reading our writing. Later in the half term we will be writing a news script based on an earlier class novel.



Science



Our science topic this half term is ecosystems. Children will be learning about lots of different habitats and the organisms that live within them. They will construct food chains and food webs and then sort animals into groups. Children will be using vocabulary such as herbivore, omnivore and carnivore and will also think about how humans can impact an ecosystem.


Art

Children will look at the work of Magdalene Odundo and Clarise Cliff to help inspire them to make coil pots. They will design their pots on paper first. Children will practice how to shape, form and construct coil pots. Once they have made the pots, children will evaluate them and think about ways they can improve their designs.



Geography

Children will learn about where all the Earth's water can be found. They will look closely at the water cycle. Children will find out why the weather in the UK and around the world changes daily. Finally they will learn about the reasons for the changing seasons.
