## Welcome!




# **English**

Children will plan and write their own postcards. Some children will be working on their phonics. These groups are following the Read, Write Inc programme which is designed to meet their specific reading and writing needs.



### Science

Our unit this term is 'New Year, New Goals'. We will be exploring and investigating hygiene, diet and exercise, using the following stories to help us; Whiffy Wilson the wolf who wouldn't wash and I will never eat a tomato.



## **History**

We are focusing on 'Homes through the Ages' over the Autumn term. We kick off the topic with a local area walk to see the dif-

ferent houses in our local environment. We will also be visiting Bradford Industrial Museum to look at the Victorian homes and to participate in a workshop based around Victorian houses and chores.



RE In RE we will be looking at 'How are symbols used to welcome new life?' Children will look at how life is welcomed in the Christian, Islamic and Sikh faith as well as the Humanist perspective. This will also include exploring the similarities and differences between the religions/perspectives.

Our DT topic is 'Textiles' and we will be learning the techniques of joining and planning and our end result will be to make a pouch.



#### **PSHCE**

We explore a book called The Girl Who Never Made Mistakes. Beatrice (main character) has never made mistake, but living this way is very stressful. This book helps explain how making mistakes can be a good thing!
