This half term, our topic will be 'People Who Help Us'. Children will be focusing on learning about different jobs people do to help us in society. This will include learning about doctors, nurses, dentists, vets and many more jobs,.

In maths, we will be working on numbers to 5. Children will work on recognising numbers, ordering numbers and counting out objects.

In phonics, we will be listening to sounds in the environment, children will go on a number of learning walks to hear different sounds. They will also play a number of different games where they can explore and identify different sounds. <u>Routine</u>

Most children are now settled into Nursery and are getting used to the routine of coming to school everyday. Please continue allowing your children to independently take off their coats and bags.

<u>Home time</u> Children will be let out 1 at a time at home time. Please be patient and wait for your child to be released.

School Uniform
