We hope you are well rested and are ready for the exciting learning that will be happening this term.

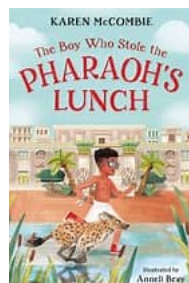
## Maths

Children will learn how to tell the time to the nearest minute. They will also look at the 24 hour clock.

They will continue to revise and consolidate learning on the four operations, fractions and the times tables.

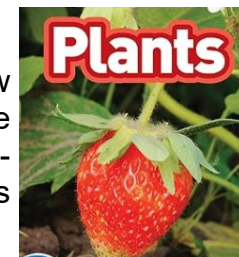
## English

This half term we are taking inspiration from *The Boy Who Stole The Pharaoh's Lunch* to write stories with portals. We are continuing to practice using speech marks and proof reading our writing. We will also be writing diaries about our visit to Cannon Hall Farm.



## Science

This half term we are continuing our studies on plants. We will grow some peas. We will be tasting pea shoots when they have grown. We are investigating what happens to plants if you deprive them of the essentials. Our school trip to Canon Hall Farm will pick up on Living Things from the last 2 half terms.



## Art

Children will look at the work of Magdalene Odundo and Clarise Cliff to help inspire them to make coil pots. They will design their pots on paper first. Children will practice how to shape, form and construct coil pots. Once they have made the pots, children will evaluate them and think about ways they can improve their designs.



## Geography

Children will learn about where all the differences between climate and weather. We will consider the polar, temperate and tropical zones. We will look at global warming.
