

Year 4 Autumn 1 2026

English

In English, we are reading a series of Greek Myths, including The Wish of Eos and King Midas.

We will be consolidating our writing features from Year 3 and further developing them further for Year 4.

Our genre of books will follow the structure of these Greek myths and how characters react when their wishes do not turn out as planned.



RE

In RE, we will be focusing on Islam. We will be learning about the five Pillars of Islam and how Muslims apply these pillars into their daily lives and how using the five pillars can lead them to having a good life.



History

This half term, we will be learning about Ancient Greece. We have looked at chronology and discussed some Ancient Greek artefacts using our oracy skills. We will be discussing the differences between our lives and the lives of Ancient Greeks. We will also be learning about the importance of archeological discoveries and how they help us to understand the past.



Guided Reading

Throughout guided reading, the children will be looking at a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts. This allows them to deepen their understanding of topics learnt in other subjects during this half term. Additionally, answering specific comprehension questions linked to our class novels.

Maths

In Maths, we are focussing on the 4-digit numbers. We will be using Base 10 and place value counters to make 4 digit numbers. We will order and compare 4 digit numbers and learn how to plot them on a number line. We will also focus on rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1,000. We will also learn how to write digits using roman numerals! In Maths, we are also recapping times tables we have learnt. We will be recapping the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10 times table.

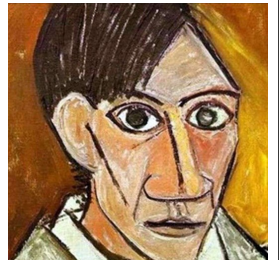


Science

This half term we will be exploring States of Matter; Solids, Liquids and Gases. We will be observing materials and objects around us to see what type of matter they are. We will be learning about how the particles behave differently within each state and what happens to these particles when they are heated up or cooled down. Look at a kettle boiling and ask your child if they can explain the processes occurring, or make ice lollies and see what happens as they cool.

Art / DT

In Art we will be looking at Portraits, in particular self portraits. We will be studying the art of Picasso and Matisse who both used quite surrealist themes in their art work, changing shapes and colours to express mood instead or keeping it life like.



Computing

To begin Year 4 computing, the children will be exploring the internet. They will investigate questions such as: What is the internet made of? What is a website? and Who owns the web? New vocabulary will be introduced alongside learning how to use the internet effectively. In addition to this, the children will recognise the need for security on the internet, how to stay safe online and evaluate content for honesty and accuracy.
