English

In English, our fiction and non - fiction text is 'Where The Wild Things Are'.

When a boat appears, Max sails to the land of the Wild Things, he finds huge, multi-coloured monsters with big claws and teeth.



We will be focusing on capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will be using the conjunction 'and' descriptive words and question marks. Children will write a sequence of sentences.

Science

Our topic this term is animals. Children will learn and name some reptiles. We will also be looking at growing some plants as we enter spring.

Maths

In Maths, we will be focusing on place value within 50. We will also be learning how to measure length, height, mass and volume. We will be using the concreate, pictorial and abstract method to develop our understanding.

Art

In Art this term, we are focusing on printing. We will be using vegetables and objects that have a pattern. We will also be using the relief printing method to create a final piece.

PE

Outdoors, we will be learning how to play Basketball and indoors we will be learning how to move our body confidently and safely through dance.

PSHCE

In PSHCE, children will identify their own strengths and what makes them individual. They will also be looking at how to use devices safely and road safety.

RE

Our unit this term is why are some festivals important in a community? We will be having lots of discussions, role playing and completing tasks to develop our understanding.

Geography

In Geography this half term, we will be focusing on map and compass work. We will be going for local walks in our local area and recognising landmarks in Bradford. We will also be making a map of our local area.

Music

In music this half term we will be recognising the pitch, pace, beat and pulse in a piece of music. Using the LauLau scheme for make are drawing alongside singing.
