Drawing club

We will be continuing to look at a variety of different books this half term, including some seasonal ones closer to the Christmas break. We will look at 2 further traditional tales and encourage children to predict a different ending or role play the story. Please speak to your child about the story which we are focusing on each week and encourage them to share the new vocabulary.



How to help your child at home

These are a few things you can help your child with:

- How to recognise their own name
- Independently put on their own coat and zip/button it up.
- Talk to your child about their day and encourage them to speak in full sentences, not just one word answers.
- Check bookbag daily for homework or reading.
- Sing counting rhymes together.



Phonics



We are continuing to work on Phonics each day. The children have been regularly assessed and are making progress with their phonics. The children are streamed into groups according to their assessments and they will continue to be assessed throughout the half term.

Some children will continue to bring home the sheets like before. Please ensure they are completing them at home.

Maths

We will build on the children's previous experiences of number from home and nursery environments, and further develop their subitising and counting skills. They will explore the composition of numbers within 5. They will begin to compare sets of objects and use the language of comparison.

This half term we will be looking at a variety of different celebrations which are celebrated by different religions around the world. This includes Diwali, Remembrance Day, and Christmas. We will perform a Nativity for school and parents.
