Maths

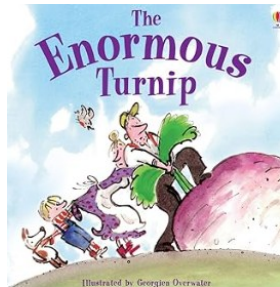
In Maths we will continue our work on addition and subtraction within 10. We will also be Learning about shape, both 2D and 3D.

PSHCE

This term in PSHCE, the children will be exploring the book *Peace at Last*. Through this story, they will learn about the importance of a good night's sleep and discover different strategies to help them relax and unwind.

Drawing Club

This half term the story we are reading is 'The Enormous Turnip'. Children will be using their phonics to write sentences. We will focus on capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. Children will also have daily phonics sessions. These groups are following the Read, Write Inc programme which is designed to meet their specific reading.



Computing

Our Computing topic is 'Computer systems'. We will look at technology all around us and consider what is technology and how we use it in our everyday life.



Science

Our topic this half term is all about Materials. We will be identifying and naming a variety of everyday objects and the materials they are made from. We are going to investigate what material is best to fix a hole in the bottom of a bucket.

Geography

This half term our focus is 'Finding my way around school'. We will be looking at different maps, learning how to use maps, and creating our own maps to use in and around the school grounds. We will be focusing on directions and using them correctly.



RE

In RE our topic is 'What does it mean to belong to a community of belief?'. We will be learning about Sikhism and their beliefs. We will be looking at Sikh's place of worship and focusing on religious symbols associated to that belief/religion.

ART

This term, our young artists will be diving into the world of drawing! They'll experiment with a variety of mark-making tools and explore how primary colours can be mixed to create secondary colours. By the end of the term, the children will proudly create their own self-portraits, showcasing the new skills and techniques they've discovered along the way.

Homework

Homework will consist of children reading their phonics reading book, spellings on Spelling Shed, completing Maths games on TT Rock Stars.
