All children are expected to read every night.

Homework tasks will be given to each year group as follows:

In addition, pupils in Year 6 will be given extra tasks by their Class Teacher as and when appropriate. This is to prepare them for the amount of homework they should expect when at secondary/high school.

Homework is more successful and has more impact on a child's progress, if:

- 1. The parent(s)/carer(s) take a keen interest in it and get involved.
- 2. It is 'hands on'. In other words, if the children are actually given a task to carry out, such as interview members of their family; make a list of certain items in the house or research something at home.
 - 3. It is returned on time. This gets your child(ren) into good learning habits.
