Authorised Absence

We have been working with the Local Authority to improve our attendance and our linked Attendance Officer from the council may get in touch with you to discuss your child's attendance if it is too low.

Please note that if your child's attendance is below 90%, absence for illness may not be automatically authorised without medical evidence.

If you need to know what evidence to provide, please speak to Mrs Khan for details.

We have also been told that the guidance around absence after your child has vomited can be relaxed from 48 hours to 24 hours if you think that your child is well enough to return to school.

Don't worry if your child does not get one this time, they can start again next term and aim for 100% attendance in the Spring and again in the Summer.
