English

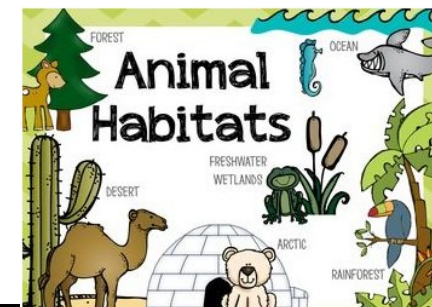


This half term, the story we are reading is *George's Marvellous Medicine* by Roald Dahl. We will continue to focus on punctuating sentences correctly using capital letters and full stops.

In addition, we will continue to work on writing sentences with conjunctions. Children will also plan and write their own stories, using ideas from the book to inspire their writing.

Science

Our unit this term is all about Living Things and their habitats and animals (Including humans). The children will be looking at different habitats around the world and which animals live in them. They will also be designing and making their own mini habitat in the form of a bird nest. They will also have the opportunity to plant their



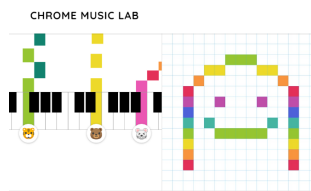
Maths

This half term, we will be finishing our unit on mass, capacity and temperature. We will then begin our Fractions unit, followed by our unit on Time.

Please note by the end of the year your child should be fluent with the 2,5, and 10 times tables. Children should use TT Rockstars at home to support this.

Computing

Our focus in computing this half term is creating media where we will be creating digital music.



The children will be using a website called 'Chrome music lab' where they will explore notes and tempo, rhythm and patterns before creating digital music based on an animal of their choice. You could have a go at home if you search 'Chrome music lab into google.

RE

This half term in RE we will be answering the focus question 'Which books and stories are important?' This question focuses on books that are special to us which will then leads us to look at and explore different religious books including the Bible, Qur'an, Guru Granth Sahib and the Torah scrolls. We will look at stories and morals; both religious and non-religious.



PSHCE

Our focus story for this half term is 'The New Girl'. The book is about new beginnings and accepting the diversity of others. We will be looking at how differences can be good.



History

Our History topic this half term is linked with Undercliffe Cemetery.

We will be visiting Undercliffe Cemetery, to look at graves, gravestones, tombs and some significant individuals who are buried there.



DT

Our DT topic this half term is focusing on Cooking and Nutrition—Balanced Diet.

We will be learning about the main food groups and identifying foods that belong to each group.

We will also be using our senses to explore different food types. Our end outcome will be to design and make a wrap.
