


# Year 2 - Spring 2 2026

## Welcome!

We hope you had a fantastic break and are ready for the exciting learning that will be happening this half

## English



This half-term, we are reading The Secret of Black Rock by Joe Todd-Stanton. Our focus will be on sentence structure, punctuation, and conjunctions. The children will also work on spellings with suffixes and common exception words.

We will explore the story through drama and hot-seating, then develop our writing skills before applying them to our own stories. Additionally, we will write a letter to residents to help save Black Rock.

## Science

This term in science, we will learn how to look after ourselves. We will learn that humans and animals have babies and need food, water, and air to live. We will talk about babies and their parents and learn why eating well, exercising, and keeping clean help us stay healthy.

## Maths

We will be finishing our unit on multiplication and division facts.

In our new unit, we will be learning about measurement, including length, height, mass, capacity, and temperature.

Please note that by the end of the year, your child should be fluent with the 2, 5, and 10 times tables.

## Geography

This half-term in Geography, we are learning about capital cities around the world and comparing the UK to a non-European city. We will explore human and physical features, discussing how they are similar or different. We will also learn what life is like in a non-European city.



## RE

This term in RE, we are learning about promises in the Bible.

We will explore the stories of Esau and Jacob, Joseph, and the birth of Jesus. We will discuss why these stories are important, how Jesus was a special baby, and how Christians believe God kept His promises.



## PSHCE

In PSHCE the book we will be focusing on is called 'Aliens Love Underpants'. The focus will be around 'keeping pants private' and spreading the importance of acceptable physical contact. The children will understand how to protect themselves and how to deal with uncomfortable situations.

## Computing

The children will be learning all about creating a tally and pictograms. The children will learn how to collect data using a tally chart and then create a pictogram using a simple program.
